

Health Requirements for the 2023-2024 Academic Year

1. Immunization Requirements

Immunization requirements apply to all full-time undergraduate and graduate students under 30 years of age and all full- and part-time health science students. Meningococcal requirements apply to the group specified in the table below.

Tdap	1 dose; Td or Tdap should be given if it has been ≥ 10 years since Tdap.
Hepatitis B	3 doses; laboratory evidence of immunity acceptable; 2 doses of Heplisav-B given on or after 18 years of age are acceptable.
MMR	2 doses; first dose must be given on or after the 1 st birthday and second dose must be given ≥ 28 days after first dose; laboratory evidence of immunity acceptable.
Varicella	2 doses; first dose must be given on or after the 1 st birthday and second dose must be given ≥ 28 days after first dose; laboratory evidence of immunity acceptable.
Meningococcal	1 dose; 1 dose MenACWY (formerly MCV4) required for all full-time students 21 years of age or younger. The dose of MenACWY vaccine must have been received on or after the student's 16 th birthday. Doses received at younger ages do not count towards this requirement. Students may decline MenACWY vaccine after they have read and signed the MDPH Meningococcal Information and Waiver Form . Meningococcal B vaccine is not required and does not meet this requirement.

AIC strongly encourages all students and employees to stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines and boosters

2. Physical Exam

All students must submit a physical exam completed by a licensed health care provider. If you are a student-athlete, your physical exam must be conducted no sooner than **6 MONTHS** prior to beginning participation in intercollegiate athletics.

3. Health Insurance

Students must submit an enrollment/waiver form **every year**. To complete the process, go to https://my.aic.edu/ICS/Offices/Office_of_Student_Accounts/Student_Health_Insurance.jnz. Please contact the Office of Student Accounts (413.205.3254) for questions related to student health insurance.

Additional Requirements for Student-Athletes:

- Pre-Participation Screening Form to be completed by a licensed health care provider.
- Sickle cell trait screening/solubility blood test (newborn screening, Sickledex or Hemoglobin S).

Additional Requirements for Health Science Students (Nursing, PT, OT)

- 2-step Mantoux test (TB skin test/PPD). QuantiFERON-TB Gold is also accepted.
- Seasonal Influenza (flu) vaccine.
