
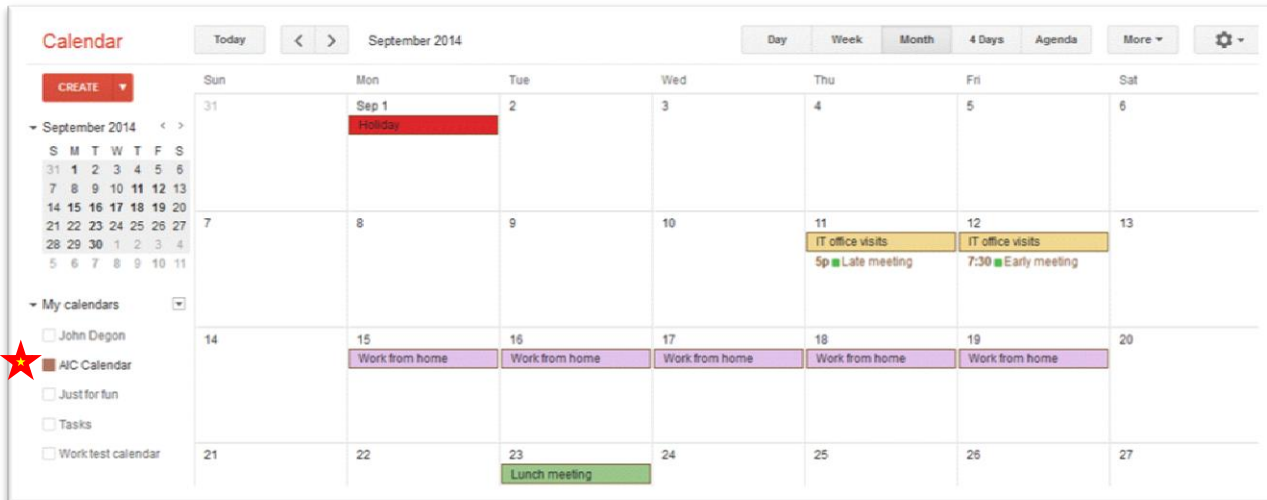


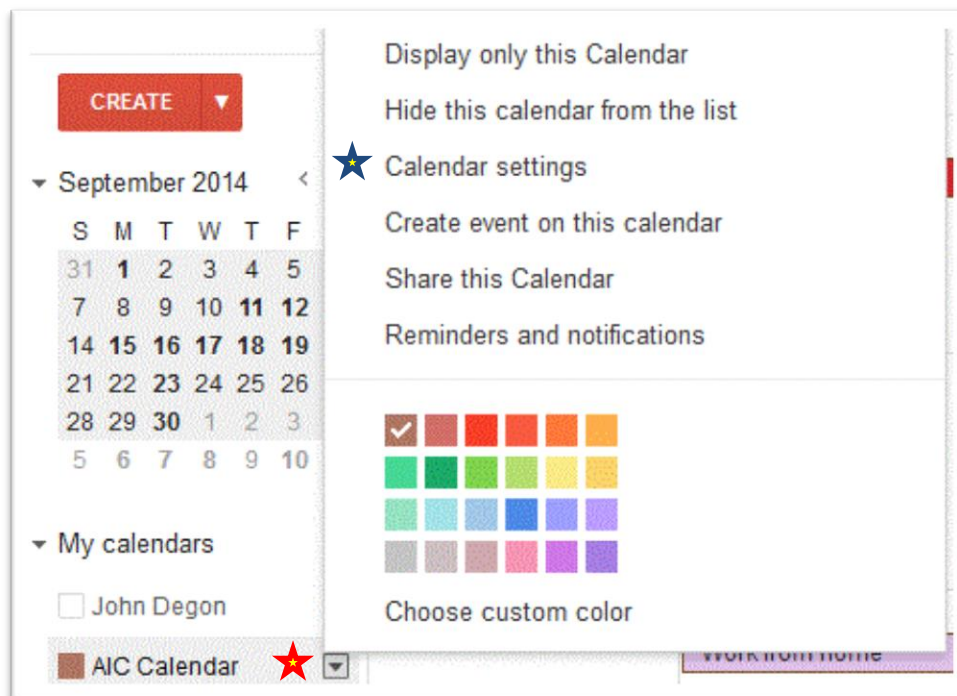


Exporting Google calendars to Outlook

1. In your **Google calendar** list on the left side of the page, highlight the calendar  to export.



2. Click the drop-down arrow  next to the calendar name and select **Calendar settings** .



3. In the **Private Address**★ section at the bottom of the page, click the **ICAL** button.★
